Meeting 5: March 21, 2019



Summary of Study

**Group 1: *Brainstorm ideas for what it is going to take to upgrade the AUDITORIUM at the JSHS. Focus on the following:***

- Replace flooring
- \$139,000.00 for replacing seating
- Currently 530 seats
- ADA compliancy
- Sound improvement
- Curtain in poor condition. Is it fire resistant?
- More microphones/headsets
- HVAC controls upgraded
- Cat walk needs to be reinstalled to better access equipment
- Replace soundboard
- Flip-down monitors
- Electrical outlets relocated to stage would eliminate wires wrapping around.
- Speakers need upgrade/ store in locked cabinet
- Replace pull-down screen (current screen is torn in places)
- Permanent set up in sound booth with enclosure and locking mechanism
- Expand storage space
- Dressing room space needed (currently using hallway)
- Idea of generating revenue from the Auditorium
- Additional electrical outlets

**Group 2: Determine how we can operate the District without closing any elementary buildings. Focus on reconfiguring the elementary buildings by grade level (K-2/3-4/5-6).**

**\*Be sure to consider capacity for each building\***

- Lake-Noxen 25 classrooms
- Lehman Jackson 25 classrooms
- Ross 19 classroom
- Grades K, 1 & 2 in Lehman-Jackson,
- Grades 3 & 4 in Ross
- Grade 5 & 6 in Lake-Noxen (2 story building)

- More space available if enrollment increases.
- Issue with transportation:
  1. Staggered start times?
  2. Buses for different schools (grade levels) would be picking up students in the same neighborhood.
  3. All students bused to central location, then shuttled.
  4. Earlier bus pick-up times and later drop-off times
  5. Before and after school care issues
- Transportation cost increase
- Special considerations for Special Education
- Enrollment increase causes building changes

**Group 3: Determine how we can consolidate the District to operate using 2 elementary buildings. Focus on which 2 elementary building we would occupy based off capacity**

- Keep Lake-Noxen and Lehman-Jackson open (K-5th grade)
- Relocate 6th grade to JSHS
- Close Ross – geographically farthest.
- Could generate revenue from Ross Elementary
- L-N could absorb student population
- L-N is two story building with adequate parking
- Community fields nearby/ Harveys Lake Community
- Transportation would run smoother/cost savings
- Least amount of disruption to students, staff and faculty
