## Accelerated Reader Lake-Lehman Junior High School

The Pennsylvania Department of Education and the Lake-Lehman Junior High School Language Arts Department are committed to improving our students' independent reading levels. The Accelerated Reader Program is a nation-wide program which has been created as a way for students to independently achieve this goal. Each marking period (every 45 school days) students will be required to earn **10 Accelerated Reader Points (20 points for Honors 7; 25 for Honors 8)**. In order to accomplish this, each student must do the following:

1. Complete the STAR test and have your language arts teacher explain your results.

2. Consult OPAC, <u>www.arbookfind.com</u>, your librarian, or your teacher for help in locating a book that is specific to your reading level or reading range.

## <u>Double-check the reading level and point value in www.arbookfind.com before</u> <u>checking out a book. Sometimes Renaissance Learning Co. changes point values.</u>

- 3. Log your book with your language arts teacher.
- 4. Set deadlines for reading each 1/3 of your AR book.
- 5. Take notes as you read.
- 6. See your teacher for an AR pass when you have finished the book.
- 7. Take the book and your AR pass to the library or a language arts teacher's study hall to complete the test for your book.
- 8. Once you have completed the test, record your results on your log, look for a new book on your reading level, and repeat the steps above.

**Special Note**: Students have access to over 100,000 Accelerated Reader tests. The Lake-Lehman Junior-Senior High School Library does not contain every Accelerated Reader book. By using <u>www.arbookfind.com</u>, students can determine if a book in their home collection or another library is actually AR compatible.

## Parents need to be aware that school personnel cannot screen each item a student chooses to read and test.

Accelerated Reader due dates have been posted and given to students. If a student does not earn the required points in a marking quarter, a 0% grade will be given for Accelerated Reader for that quarter. If a student is caught cheating on an AR test, a 0% for that test will be issued. Each marking period, every AR test a student has taken will be averaged into one final grade and recorded on eBook. It is important that the student read books which are appropriate to his/her reading level to avoid failing multiple tests and reducing the overall test average. If a student does not earn all required points in a marking period, at the teacher's discretion, the overall test average may be dropped to a 50%, even if the student has passed each test taken but has not earned the required points.
