

FID- Flexible Instruction Day/Virtual Google Day

School districts have the option to use a FID when it is necessary to close school. During these days, students will work from home on school assignments. A FID is different than a regular snow closure, where no work is expected to be completed from home.

When a Flexible Instruction Day (FID) is used, please follow the instructions below:

- ❖ Students will have access to teachers from 8:30 AM- 3:30 PM via email.**
- ❖ K-2 students will have packets to work from during the FID day. Students must return all work to school in order to receive attendance and work credit for the day.**
- ❖ Students in grades 3-6 will access their work through Google Classroom. Students must complete the attendance form in order to receive attendance credit for the day.**
- ❖ Students in grades 7-12 will access their work through Google Classroom. Students must complete the attendance form for each class period in order to receive attendance credit for the day.**
