

Information for Parents/Guardians Google Classroom Instruction Days

The district will begin to institute Google Classroom Instruction Days on certain days when school is canceled. We are attempting to preserve some continuity of education with all of the weather cancellations, as well as maintain a reasonable school calendar. We have already accumulated seven snow days and we still have a lot of winter remaining. Google Classroom Instruction Days will count as a school day.

All students in grades K-12 have a school issued Chromebook that can be used on Google Classroom Instruction Days. Teachers will assign work via Google Classroom, and students are expected to complete this work throughout the day. Assignments will be posted by 10 a.m. and are expected to be completed by the end of the student school day. Some assignments may be electronic and completed via Google forms or submitted with Kami, other examples include reading assignments, completing work started the previous day in class, preparing for quizzes/tests, using online learning sites such as AR, Reading at to Z, Aleks, or Connect Ed.

LL Cyber, LL LVST and Traditional Students will all participate in school work on any day that is designated as a Google Classroom Instruction Day. LL Cyber students will simply continue their work in the cyber platform. All other students will access their work through Google Classroom. K-2 may have hard copy work instead provided by the teacher in advance.

Assignments will be relative to current curriculum and **MANAGEABLE** at home for students and parents/guardians. This work is not intended to create a hardship for anyone, rather keep the flow of learning in instances where school must be closed.

Teachers of students in grades K-2 have the option to use Google Classroom for their work, or they may send paper/pencil work home with each student if we know in advance of weather or other circumstances, that we will likely close school. The work will be accounted for upon completion

No Zoom meetings will be occurring on the GC Instruction Days. These days are intended to be independent work days for students.
