Dr. Boback graduated from Harvard University School of Dentistry Class of 2014 with a Doctor of Dental Medicine (DMD) . He received the prestigious Grace Milliken Award and graduated with Honors in Research for his work in designing and carrying out in vitro experiments in the Dr. Roland Baron Group concerning the studies of insulin pathways and relation to bone growth and development in various cell lines/transgenic mouse models.

Bernard assisted the Dr. Brenden Manning Group in the research of various cell-signaling pathways in the Department of Genetics and Complex diseases at the Harvard School of Public Health and is featured in two manuscripts presented in 2013 ASBMR Conference.
