Progress Reports Available on eSchoolData

First marking period progress reports will be available on October 2nd for students in grades 1 through 6. Select PARENTS from the left side of the home screen, choose eSchoolData-Parents. Contact our helpdesk if you are unable to access your student(s) information by sending an email to helpdesk.org. To receive a paper copy to be sent home, you must make the request in writing to your child's teacher.

Only one form per family needs to be filled out and should include educational value to qualify as an educational absence. All submitted forms will be approved. You will hear from the office, only if there is an issue.

Single-day family day trips will be excused from a written note or an absence slip.
