

## PUBLIC NOTICE

### LAKE-LEHMAN SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER VACANCY – Region II

---

The Board of School Directors of the Lake-Lehman School District is seeking letters of interest to fill a vacancy on the Board in Region II due to a recent resignation.

In accordance with Pennsylvania School Code and the Sunshine Act, the Board of School Directors intend to fill the vacancy at a public meeting to be held on Monday, April 15, 2024. The individual appointed will serve for the remainder of the term expiring the first Monday in December, 2025.

Additionally, in accordance with section 322 of the Public School Code of 1949 as amended, eligibility is limited to any citizen of this commonwealth, having a good moral character, being at least eighteen (18) years of age, and having been a resident of the district for at least one (1) year, prior to the date of his election or appointment. The Lake-Lehman School District elects school directors through a regional election plan, therefore, an appointee for a regional seat must reside in the region they will be representing. There are further limitations relating to those who hold other government offices or positions in the School District.

Eligible candidates will be interviewed at the April 15, 2024 School Board Meeting.
